It's that time again! Registration begins on June 26th and runs through July 25th for High School and July 28th for Middle School. This league is for kids in the 6th - 12th grade during the 2011-2012 school year. The cost this year is \$65 and we will have an end of season tournament. Evaluations for high school are July 25th at 7:00 p.m.; for middle school girls July 26th, and middle school boys July 28th at 7:00 p.m. During the evaluations, there will be a parent meeting in the Christian Life Center classrooms to go over a few of the rules/expectations of the league and will last about 30 min. Practices begin the week of August 15th and games begin September 10th. The season will at least go through Nov. 5th or possibly the following week to complete the tournament. It is important for every player to come to evaluations. Please make an effort to have your child there and for at least one parent to stay for the meeting.
